- Drop off for donated goods will be at the Wootton HS auditorium lot on Friday May 27th from 4:00 PM to 7:00 PM and Saturday May 28th from 7:00 AM to 8:00 AM.
- All proceeds from the yard sale will be used to support the Wootton Band & Orchestra Programs.
- We will be sending out a separate sign up genius for parent volunteers to help manage the Yard Sale and the students need to help as well. Volunteers will be needed to help with parking, pricing, set up, take down, and collecting payment for purchases. We will also need to borrow canopies and folding tables.
- Following the end of the Yard Sale any unsold items will be donated to a local charity organization.

Please see below for a listing of acceptable and unacceptable donation items.

All donated items must be fully operational and meet government regulations.

All donated items must be less than 50 pounds.

Acceptable Items:

- Unopened cosmetics and toiletries
- Eyeglasses/sunglasses, artificial flowers and trees, umbrellas, yarn
- Jewelry
- Clothing and shoes
- Luggage Blankets and bedding, quilts, pillows and pillow cases, draperies, towels, rugs 6X9 or smaller
- Collectibles, knick-knacks, antiques, framed pictures and paintings
- Holiday decorations
- Kitchenware (e.g., dishes, utensils, flat/silverware, pots/pans, Tupperware, glasses, serving plates)
- Yard tools, hardware tools
- Books, CDs, DVDs
- Toys (e.g., bicycles, tricycles, board games, stuffed animals, video game software)
- Small appliances (e.g., irons, ironing boards, sewing machines, microwaves, clocks, hair dryers, blenders, coffee makers, toasters) Electronics (flat screen TVs, computer items such as towers, printers, flat screen drives, software and accessories, telephones, smart phones, answering machines, portable copiers, fax machines, stereos, DVD players, video cameras)
- Musical Instruments
- Sporting goods (e.g., camping equipment, sporting equipment, fitness items)
- Small furniture weighing less than 50 lbs (e.g., end tables, coffee tables, lamps, night stands, etc.)

Unacceptable Items:

- Firearms or weapons or ammunition
- Electronics such as Tube TVs and tube computer monitors
- Large appliances (e.g., dishwashers, dryers, washers, heaters, stoves, refrigerators, AC units)
- Furniture (e.g., particle board, wicker furniture, soiled furniture, furniture exceeding 50 lbs, including bedroom sets, dining room sets, living room sets, office desks, upholstered furniture, loveseats, sofas, futons, mirrors, dressers/chests, entertainment centers, pianos)
- Household items (e.g., BBQ grills and tanks, carpets, fans, bottles, cans, liquids and food, crutches and walkers, wheelchairs and scooters, gas tools, hangers, auto rims, tires, ramps, exercise equipment, lawn mowers, gas weed eaters and edgers)
- Beds (e.g., frames, head/footboards, rollaways and cots, box springs, mattresses or convertible beds and waterbeds)
- Reference Books and periodicals (e.g., encyclopedia, magazines, periodicals, newspapers)
- Baby Items (e.g., bassinets, car seats, carriages, changing tables, playpens, baby walkers, high chairs and strollers)
- Any item not allowed on school property
